

LaPlata West Water Authority MOU / Statement of Board

Adopted: 10-14-2020

The LPWWA Board of Directors (the Authority) shall allow **multi-tap** Subscription Holders, who have parcels of land with one subscription at a dwelling unit and the other subscription(s) on vacant land parcels, each with a separate meter, that are invoiced (and that pay) base rate fees at multiple locations, may apply to the Authority for approval to use the **combined total** of their base rate allowance of 3,000 gallons per month per Subscription, at the multi-tap Subscriber's dwelling unit location.

Multi-tap Subscribers must apply to the Authority in writing, prior to the next billing period to be able to aggregate their base rate allowance at one location in the upcoming billing period. The Authority, through the Subscriber's written application, will set a time duration for the combined usage the Subscriber will be allowed. It will be determined by reviewing the Subscriber's application and the capacity at the location of all the line(s). All meters will be monitored by our Operator, through our WaterScope program. The vacant parcels subscription will not be allowed any water use until released from the dwelling unit, which requires written notice to the Authority requesting the release in writing 30-days prior to the next billing cycle.

Once released, the vacant parcel with the subscription can use the base rate allowance of 3,000 gallons per month and the dwelling unit will revert to its original 3,000 gallons per month.

If you have vacant land where a meter is set, you are encouraged use of some type of 'shut off valve' and 'hydrant/spigot' on the parcel(s) and use your 3,000+ gallons. All LPWWA Rules & Regulations apply.

All connects and extensions to LPWWA's meters require an inspection, even spigots.
